House Bill Descriptions

1 = House Bill 71: Unborn Victims of Violence Act (2007) -
(Supported by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

Pro-life bill that would acknowledge the death of the unborn child in a case such as a vehicular homicide of a pregnant woman where both the mother and the unborn victim were killed. (This bill passed the Florida House but was not taken up in the Senate chamber)

2 = Senate Bill 134: Cardrooms and Dominoes (2007) -
(Opposed by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

This bill expanded gambling at pari-mutuels (Jai-alai, dog tracks and horse tracks) for onsite gambling in cardrooms to include playing a defined game of dominoes. (This bill passed both chambers, and became Florida law without being signed by the Governor)

3 = Senate Bill 500: Instant Bingo Scratch-off Cards (2007) -
(Opposed by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

This bill was vetoed the previous year by Governor Bush because it expands gambling in the state of Florida to include lottery-like scratch-off bingo cards. (This bill passed both chambers and was signed into law by the Governor of the state of Florida)

4 = Senate Bill 752: Cardrooms (2007) -
(Opposed by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

Another gambling bill that authorizes poker tournaments, and allows for larger betting limits and more positions at the "table." (This bill passed both chambers, and became Florida law without being signed by the Governor)

5 = Amendment to House Bill 1047: Slot Machine Gaming (2007) -
(Opposed by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

This amendment changes existing Florida law to allow check cashing within the slot machine gaming area of pari-mutuel facilities that have slot machines. (This amendment passed on its second attempt because three Representatives switched their votes to "Yes")

6 = House Bill 1047 on Final Passage: Slot Machine Gaming (2007) -
(Opposed by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

Gambling bill that increases the hours of play and number of slot machines per facility. It also makes it easier to get additional money for playing slot machines at pari-mutuel facilities by allowing ATM machines on the premises and check cashing in the slot machine gaming area. (This bill passed both chambers, and became Florida law without being signed by the Governor)

7 = House Bill 1065: Ethical Stem Cell Research (2007) -
(Supported by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

Pro-life bill that would create a Biomedical Research Trust Fund for stem cell research on adult and umbilical cord stem cells but would prohibit the use of embryonic stem cells that require the destruction of a human embryo. (This bill passed out of two House committees but did not make it any farther)

8 = House Bill 1231: Increased Penalty for Prostitution (2007) -
(Supported by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

Crime bill that would increase the penalty for procuring a minor for the purposes of prostitution. (This bill passed the Florida House but was not taken up in the Senate chamber)

9 = Amendment to the Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 1376: Department of the Lottery (2007) -
(Opposed by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

This amendment was offered by the House sponsor as an amendment that was friendly to the gambling interests and their desire to further expand gambling in Florida. (This amendment to the Senate bill was defeated)

10 = Senate Bill 1456: School Supply Tax Holiday (2007) -
(Supported by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

This bill allows for a specified period of time to be a tax-free holiday for the purpose of purchasing school supplies and clothing prior to the 2007-2008 school year. (This bill passed and became law)

11 = House Bill 1497: Parental Notice of a Minor's Abortion (2007) -
(Supported by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

This bill sought to repair a glitch in the Judicial Bypass process for minors who were seeking an abortion in the state of Florida. (The House passed a stronger version of this bill and refused to concur with the Senate version, therefore both bills died)

12 = Senate Bill 1604: Sexual Predators Registry (2007) -
(Supported by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

This bill revises criteria for designation as sexual predator, requires said predators to register with FDLE through the sheriff's office, and increases frequency of re-registration requirement for said predator. (This bill passed both chambers and became Florida law)

13 = House Bill 7145: Education Scholarship Programs (2007) -
(Supported by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

This bill seeks to improve the quality of education in this state by both expanding educational opportunities for children and creating incentives for schools to achieve excellence. (This bill passed both chambers and was signed into law by the Governor)

14 = Senate Joint Resolution 4 (Special Session B): Property Tax Reform (2007) -
(Supported by the Christian Coalition of Florida)

This proposed Amendment to the Florida Constitution regarding property tax reform will go before the voters on the General Election ballot for approval/rejection in November of 2008.

1 = Senate Bill 134: Cardrooms and Dominoes (2007) -
(Opposed by the Christian Coalition of Florida)
 See description for #2 under the "House Bill Descriptions"

2 = Senate Bill 216: High Stakes Poker Tournaments (2007) -
(Opposed by the Christian Coalition of Florida)
 Gambling bill would have allowed high stakes poker tournaments in existing pari-mutuels. (This bill was voted down in committee)

3 = Senate Bill 500: Instant Bingo Scratch-off Cards (2007) -
(Opposed by the Christian Coalition of Florida)
 This bill expands gambling in the state of Florida to include lottery-like scratch-off bingo cards. (This bill passed both chambers and was signed into law by the Governor of the state of Florida)

4 = Senate Bill 750: Biomedical Research (2007) -
(Opposed by the Christian Coalition of Florida)
 Bill that would allow the destruction of human life via embryonic stem cell research. (This bill passed out of two Senate committees and did not make it any farther)

5 = Senate Bill 752: Cardrooms (2007) -
